Scott Allen Orrell, 66, of Saluda, passed away on May 12, 2024.

Scott was born in Richmond, Virginia on August 21, 1957. He graduated in 1975 from York Academy in Shacklefords and was a professional driver for over 40 years working with Pitts Lumber Company, Williams Mail Service, Norton Food Company, Urbanna Lumber Company, and Massey Building Supply. Scott loved restoring and tinkering with antique vehicles or boats, cavorting with pirates, and was known for baking an exceptionally delicious rum cake.

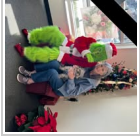
