February 21, 1960 - March 14, 2015

Sondra Lee Ludwig, age 55, passed away at Duke University Medical Center on March 14, 2015, surrounded by family. The cause was complications from a stem cell transplant treating Acute Myeloid Leukemia.

Born February 21, 1960 in Washington D.C. to Thomas and Margaret Joan Langenfeld, she attended the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire in 1978 and graduated from the University of Maryland in 2010. On November 17, 1979, she married Jeffery Kent Ludwig.

Sondra lived in a multitude of cities as a military spouse from Fort Lee, Virginia to Pusan, South Korea with Jeffery and their children. She held numerous administrative assistant positions throughout her career at Progress Index Regional Newspaper, Physical Therapy Rehabilitation Center, Southside Regional Medical Center, and Magdovitz Clinic. Sondra then worked as a teacher's aide at Pusan American School for the kindergarten class. Finally, she worked at the Heritage Public Library in New Kent County. Sondra was a member Providence Forge Presbyterian Church.

Sondra will be especially remembered for being a loving and devoted daughter, sister, wife, mother, and grandmother. Her passion in life was her family. Nothing brought her more joy in life than being a mother and grandmother.
