We have never forgotten it. We have shared the story of how hard you guys worked many, many times.*

*Even though time has passed, I wanted to reach out and let you know how sorry I am for this huge loss in your life. I will pray for all of you, especially the ones closest to Stacy who are left without him.*

*My time as a faculty member at NKHS still brings me joyful memories. I often think of all the students who had to suffer through my grammar and composition lessons. A teacher never forgets her first round of students.*
