Starr F Canale passed away on Monday, July 9th following a long and courageous battle with numerous complex health conditions.

Starr was born in Monterey, California and raised in nearby Marina, where she loved to swim, ride her horse and roller-skate as a child. In high school, she was a member of the swim team, loved cheer-leading and graduated from Monterey High School in the class of '89. Starr began working as a Pharmacy Technician and soon met her future husband Anthony. Together for 28 years, Starr loved to travel and together as an Army couple they lived in California, Tennessee, Hawaii, Germany and Virginia. She lived life to the fullest and was typically a little over dressed for any occasion. She always wore high heels, carried a Louie or Gucci purse and was one beautiful and classy lady. As a proud Army wife, she supported her husband and family through four combat deployments and raised her two sons Kyle and Chad, sometimes on her own. She served her country as an Army civilian and Pharmacy Technician for over 14 years until health complications forced her to resign and focus on her health and her family.

Starr or "Dar", as she was affectionately called by Anthony, loved living life to

its fullest; though not necessarily on everyone's time schedule. She loved her boys. She enjoyed shopping, dancing while she cooked dinner for her family, listening to music and her adorable pets. She always drove a "pretty car" and was the walking definition of a classy lady. Starr truly loved her family pets and she considered them all her four-legged children. Many are long deceased, but she is with each of them now. Jake, Jesse, Hercules, Tiger, Leece and the chinchillas are together with their Momma, now keeping a watchful eye over her boys.

She missed the morning session starting time by 10 minutes and had to wait for the afternoon session, which was the session I was attending. It was a long drive back and she asked me to follow her. No problem, we were heading in the same direction. Well, she started getting tired because she had gotten up quite early as she did everyday. She called me on the phone and asked me to take the lead and find us a place to pull off. Well, I say a brightly lit "Ausfahrt" and we pulled in not knowing that it was lit up like a Christmas tree because it was a random check point. The polizei checked our licenses and registration and told me that I was free to go, but because Starr was tired she slurred her words a little and she had to stay. Needless to say, it ended up being a very long night. They made me leave, but after an hour or two of waiting the Polizei called me and told me to come back and calm my friend down. Neither of us spoke German fluently and they wanted to take blood from Starr. I remember her telling me that they kept speaking German to her and she didn't understand why. It was comical. The story is longer, but I am sure you get the point. Starr was memorable, if nothing else. She will be missed!

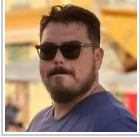
