Steven C. Bohannon Sr., 75, of Shacklefords, VA passed away June 27, 2025.

Born on January 11, 1950, Steve grew up in West Point, VA, with a brief time spent in Salisbury, MD. Known and loved by many from an early age, Steve was a standout athlete, playing both football and baseball throughout his school years. After graduating high school, he attended Chowan College before serving as a reservist in the National Guard for six years.

Steve is survived by his three children, Tara (Scott), Christie, and Steven Jr.; his grandchildren, Taylor, Madison, Autumn, Ava, and Blake; his brothers, David (Cindy) and Bill (Teresa); his sister, Jane (Tommy); and his beloved dog, Susie. He was preceded in death by his mother, Juliet Bohannon and father, Willie (Jr.) Bohannon.

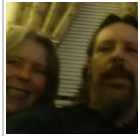
