Thad Crawford Merrill, 89, of Barhamsville, passed away peacefully on September 29, 2015. TC left his beloved mountains when he was asked to fight in WWII. He served in the U.S. Army in Germany as a radio operator. He returned to work many jobs, attend college, and marry his childhood sweetheart before eventually moving to Newport News, where he retired from the NN Shipyard. TC was always involved in his children's lives. He especially loved watching them play sports and coaching them in little league.

Thad was preceded in death by his beloved wife of over 50 years, Lucille; two sons, Thad "Butch" and Jon Michael "Mike" Merrill; and two sisters, Katherine Franklin and Willie Capps.
