Mihalcoe and moved to Northern Virginia where she worked in the Main Navy Department as a secretary for John Warner. Inez and her husband also owned and operated several Pizza Shops and once they moved to Williamsburg started Olde Towne Pizza in the early 70s. Inez was also a realtor with Century 21. Being adventurous she also earned her pilots license and recreationally flew.
