



## Thomas Spivey,

January 6, 1938 - September 30, 2011

Spivey, Thomas Dawson, Jr., 73, of King and Queen died September 30, 2011 and went to heaven to be with his Lord and Savior. He was born in Henrico County, Virginia to Thomas and Ruby Spivey on January 6, 1938. He was predeceased by his parents and by his wife, Charlotte Nuckols Spivey.
