



## Walter Fielder Littreal Jr.

April 8, 1944 - April 22, 2023

Walter Fielder “Bill” Littreal, Jr., 79, of West Point, passed away unexpectedly on April 22, 2023. Bill was born in Pulaski County on April 8, 1944, and he graduated from Fries High School in 1962. Following graduation Bill married the love of his life, Carolyn Campbell Littreal and they just celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary in February. Bill proudly served the Commonwealth of Virginia as a devoted member of the Virginia State Police for 31 years. Bill often answered to “Coach” from his many years of dedicated service as a volunteer coach in West Point. 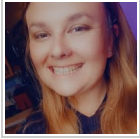
