Warren Charlie Cotman was born March 10, 1970 to his parents Wilnette Wiley and Charlie Warren Cotman, Jr. in Richmond, VA. Warren was a devoted husband to his wife Lisa Hall Cotman. Together they had four beautiful daughters, Porscha, Gabrielle, Micaiah, and Marie.

Warren attended Highland Springs High School in 1984, where he met the love of his life. He then graduated from Manchester High School in 1988 where he was a member of the Manchester Lancers basketball team, receiving accolades and recognition for his outstanding sportsmanship.

Warren was baptized at the age of 16 at Richmond Christian Center (RCC) and when immersed from the water anew, God gave him the revelation that he was called to minister the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Warren was a trail blazing faithful servant of God and graduated from the school of Ministry at RCC. 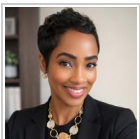
