



## Wilbur Franklin Fletcher

December 20, 1928 - March 29, 2018

Wilbur Franklin Fletcher, 89, of West Point, VA and a long-time resident of Eltham, VA, passed away March 29, 2018.

Wilbur was a graduate of Botetourt High School in 1946. He was an Army veteran, a member of West Point Masonic Lodge #238 AF & AM for over 50 years, as well as a member of First Baptist Church of West Point for many years.
