William (Bill) Reginald McTheny, 82, of Lanexa, VA passed away unexpectedly Monday, June 17, 2013. He was born June 24, 1930 in Gassaway, West Virginia to James Corbitt and Ruth McTheny. Bill had four brothers and a sister who preceded him in death.
