William H. Womack, Jr. entered into eternal rest on December 2, 2020 at MCV Hospital in Richmond, Virginia at the age of 65.

William, affectionately known as “Wimpy” , was born to the late William H. Womack, Sr. and Josephine B. Womack. He attended elementary school in Prince Edward County for three years. After his parents moved to Petersburg, Virginia, he continued his education in the Petersburg School System. He graduated from Petersburg High School in 1975. His graduating class was referred to as the “First Class” because his class was the first class to graduate from the newly built Petersburg High School. William played on the PHS football team, wrestling team and baseball team. In 1974, he was voted the Best High School Center by the Virginia High School Athletic League. After graduating from high school (1975), he served in the United States Air Force. William earned an Associate Degree in Liberal Arts from St. Leo University, Fort Lee, VA. He retired from Defense Supply Center in 2009, after thirty-four years of service.

William married Gerri of Charles City, Virginia on September 20, 1980. They resided in Charles City for the duration of their forty year marriage. They were blessed with two sons, Brandon and Brian.

He accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Triumph Baptist

Church in Darlington Heights, VA. He later joined St. John Baptist Church where he remained active until his passing. He began working in SJBC immediately by first joining the Usher Board where he served for several years. He also served as Vice-Chair of the Trustee Board and member of the Men's Fellowship.

William gained many friends and accolades through the many auxiliaries, teams and organizations he joined and participated in. He volunteered with No Greater Love and served as Assistant Chief of the Charles City Volunteer Fire Department. He served on the Charles City Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, the Charles City County Fire Committee, treasurer of Wayside Gun Club, member of the Charles City NAACP, and member of the American Legion Post #61. He also served as assistant football coach for the Petersburg and Charles City County High School football teams.

William enjoyed fishing, hunting and traveling. He loved to entertain family and friends in his backyard. He spear-headed many family and friends vacations and trips.

In addition to his parents, William was preceded in death by his sister Carol L. Womack.

He leaves to cherish his memories, his wife, Gerri; two sons, Brandon (Shannon) and Brian (Kelsea); two grand-children, Jaleel and Jioni; one brother, Larry; two brothers-in-law, Thomas Jones (Sylvia) and John Jones (Gracie); one sister-in-law, Kathy Jones; devoted cousin, Ernest Wade; god daughter, Camryn Johnson; grandson at heart, La'Vonte Crawley; best buddy, David Goode; devoted friends, David and Mary; a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, friends, and neighbors.

A graveside service will be held 1p.m., Sunday December 6, at St. John
